About title:

Honeycombs are well-known, and ants heaps attract attention. But we mostly overlook how insects living on their own care for their offspring. Weevils roll up leaves to lay their eggs, pill bugs form dung balls, and wall-dwelling bees use old snail shells. Anne Möller has observed and studied all this. And she has created drawings that explain these small miracles and make them into an adventure.

This particular insect theme, though unusual and not generally to be found in books, is a theme that fascinates children. It opens up a small world that can be found everywhere around us, on branches, in sandpits or wall cracks.
