About title:

Little bunny is lost on his way home and happens to meet a hungry fox. But things do not quite go according to the fox's plans. Bunny demands first a simple "good night", then a goodnight story, then accompaniment to bed, then a goodnight song ... and the fox plays along, always secure that he will get his delicious roast in the end. Well, he doesn't; sleep finally overwhelms him.

This is a light-hearted and amusing story about the physically weak outwitting the strong. The rhythm of the tale is set with the help of contrasts: the fear of being eaten up alternates with the joy over outsmarting the enemy. And this see-saw of emotions is forcefully supported by the strong pictures. In a naturalistic but also very human fashion the author lets the two uneven friends stumble through the night.
